## Applications will be accepted from April 1, 2023 through May 31, 2023

In accordance with City Ordinance Section 615.020, the following information is required for those applying for a refund of utility taxes paid for: **Electric & Gas (only).** 

Applicant MUST own or lease residential property located within the City limits of St. Charles & occupy the same property as their primary place of residence.

Refunds will be capped at \$125 per household.

The following documentation must be included with this application:

**PROOF OF AGE:** At least 62 years of age OR 60 years of age & receiving total disability.

**DOCUMENTATION OF TOTAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME:** Must be less than \$35,000 for one (1) person or \$45,000 for two (2) persons. Acceptable documentation includes a 2022 tax return or, Form SSA-1099 for SS income IF no tax return is required by the IRS. #### **DOCUMENTATION OF PAID ELECTRIC & GAS BILLS FOR 2022:**
